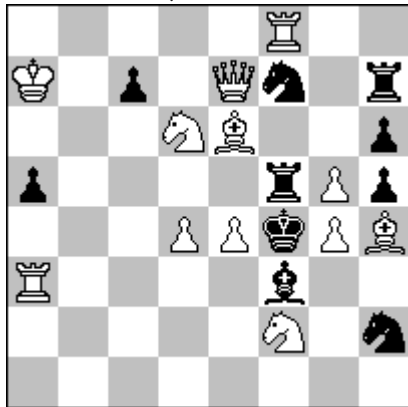
The Royal Moroccan Chess Federation (FRME) organizes the 5th TT FREM, in four 6 sections:

A) Twomovers #2 Theme: Interchange of functions between two units: A and B after the same defense "a" (or after two different defenses a/b in pseudo-form. In a try, the White piece "A" pins black piece and White piece "B" mats. In the key, the White piece "B" pins black piece and the white piece "A" gives checkmate

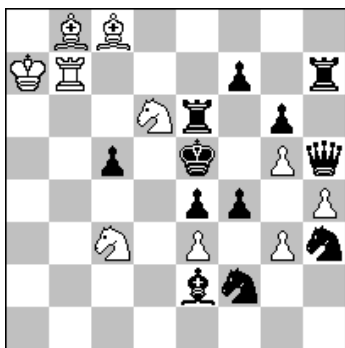
C) Moremovers #4-6 Theme: At least three defenses by black pieces on the same square on the 1st move.

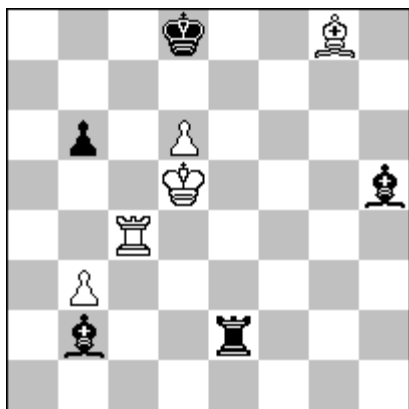

D) Endgame studies Theme: In try(tries) black draw or win using some motive (manoeuvre). In solution white win or draw using similar motive (manoeuvre).

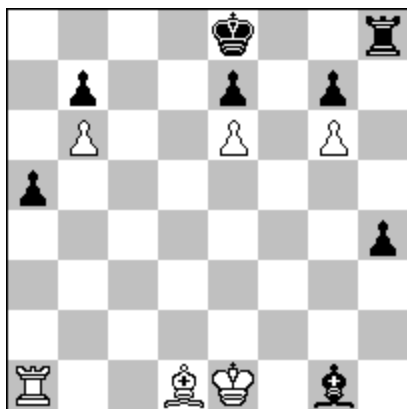

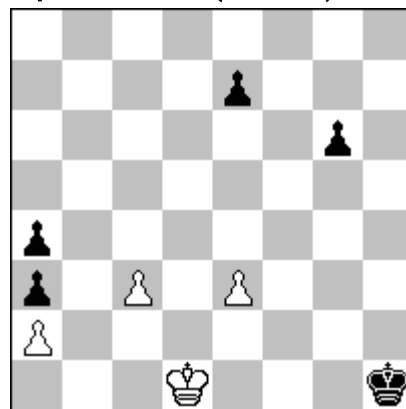

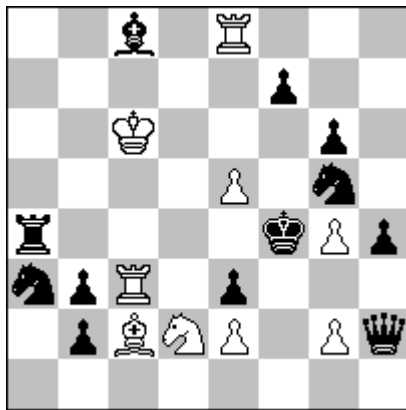

 In the final twin, of course, the solution can be without taking the thematic figure. Striptease is possible, both partial and consecutive.

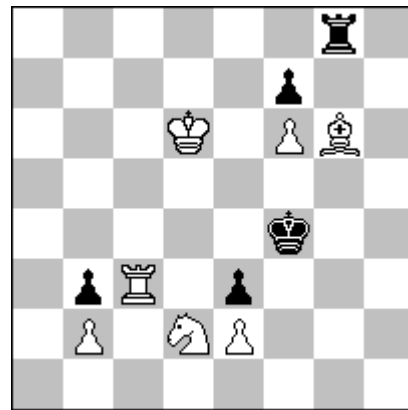

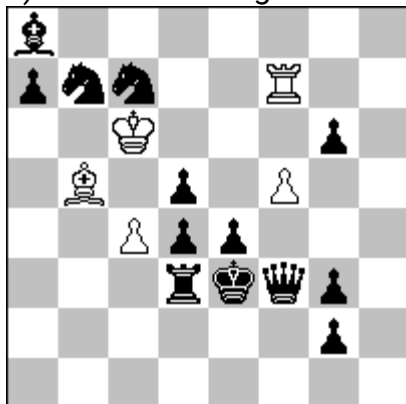
