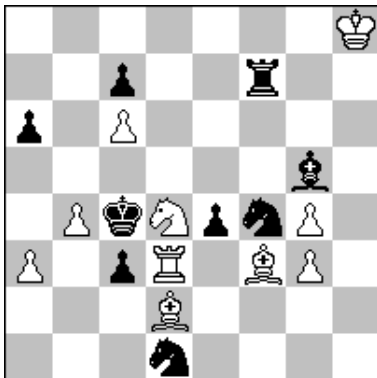

My decision is as follows:

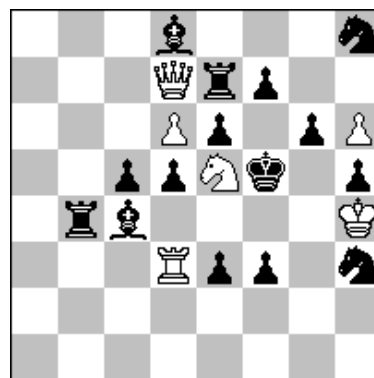
